

## HOTSPOTS FOR YOUTH UNEMPLOYMENT CARER WORKFORCE NEEDS

There are 42 hot spots in Australia with high youth unemployment and a high need for care workers

In an Australian first, we have mapped the regions with high identified care needs and high levels of youth unemployment. This has identified 42 hot spots which must be targeted as a matter of priority. The Y has established infrastructure and a track record of success on the ground in the overwhelming majority of these hot spots.
